SEEKING THE FOLLOWING ROLES

KAMI PATTERSON – Female-identifying, 21, Mezzo

Ben's older sister. Pre-med student at Yale. Disciplined, smart, and cynical. Has always been a team player in a stressful family dynamic and often defers her own needs to support Ben.

HARRY PATTERSON – Male-identifying, 40–50, Bari-tenor

Ben and Kami's widowed father. A skilled engineer and officer in the U.S. Air Force. Strong and confident externally, but internally struggles to balance family, country, and personal grief.

CHARLEY TINSELTOES - Male-identifying, 18+, Tenor

A seasoned Buddy Elf in the North Pole Special Buddies Unit (the North Pole Navy SEALS). Sent to help a hurting family in the Southern Yonder. Despite being sworn not to use magic outside the North Pole, Charley is determined to help them heal. Strong actor/singer/dancer. Acrobatic ability is a plus.



AGENT SKITTLE GOODYSPIRIT - Female-identifying, 18+, Mezzo

An elf and rule-following Junior Agent with the Christmas Intelligence Agency (CIA). Often misread as incapable due to her overwhelming cuteness. Determined to prove her strength. Actor/singer who moves well.

SNAP KRACKLE – Male-identifying, 18+, Baritone

An elf who is a practical and industrious mechanic in charge of Santa's sleigh. Gruff and bumbly with a heart of gold. The kind of elf who'd help change a tire—while grumbling about it. Actor/singer who moves well.

CAROL PATTERSON – Female-identifying, 35–45, Mezzo

Loving mother of Ben and Kami and a supportive partner to Harry. Her warmth grounds the family in the face of grief and distance.

MAYOR - Any gender identity, 35+

Mayor of Hampton Hill, Pennsylvania. Warm, slightly quirky civic leader.

COLONEL GRANT - Any gender identity, 35+

The highest-ranking officer at Fort McCoy Air Force Base in Greenland. Commanding, composed, and decisive.

WALKER - Male-identifying, 18+

A brawny and dependable Airman who serves alongside Harry. Steadfast and loyal.

ENSEMBLE – All gender identities

All ensemble should be singer/dancers. Will appear as Townsfolk, Elves, and Soldiers. **Tap training and acrobatics are a plus**. Featured vocal and character work throughout.
